

James Hollingsworth

Incumbent is Chairman of the Keesler Federal Credit Union Board of Directors serving in this capacity for over six years. Mr. Hollingsworth also serves as a Director on the Board of the National Association of Credit Union Chairmen. Prior to his election as a Keesler Federal Chairman, Mr. Hollingsworth served an associate board member, board member and treasurer. Previously, Mr. Hollingsworth served in a senior leadership position at Keesler AFB as the Director of Technical Training Operations. He served in this capacity for seven years overseeing the replenishment and training of more than 30K Air Force Airmen annually, culminating in his being awarded the Outstanding Civilian Career Service Award. Mr. Hollingsworth served 39 years on active duty with the AF and retired in the rank of full Colonel. He holds an Associate Degree in Administration Management, a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration, and a Master of Science Degree in Operations Management from the University of Arkansas. His military professional education includes Squadron Officer School, Air Command and Staff College and Air War College. In addition to his military awards and decorations, including the Legion of Merit, he won Air Education and Training Command's Chief of Staff of the Air Force Team Excellence Award twice, and Keesler's Lance Sijan Leadership Award.
